1. All exhibits to be in Marquee by **9.45am** on day of Show.
2. All exhibits must be the production and property of the exhibitor and must not have been previously entered at Honley Show.
3. The Society cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to exhibits during or after the exhibition.
4. All exhibits to be collected no earlier than 4.30pm on the day of the Show.
5. Prizes will be awarded entirely at the Judge's discretion.
6. The Council reserves the right to withhold or diminish the prize money of any class where the exhibits are considered to be of inferior quality, or where there are insufficient entries.
7. The age of the exhibitor must be stated on all Children's Entry forms.

#### **SPECIAL PRIZES**

The NHW Wood Memorial will be awarded to the school attended by the winner of the exhibit judged to be the Best Children’s Exhibit. The shield is to be retained for one year and the winner will also receive a cash prize.

The Eileen Langley Trophy to be awarded for the best Group or Class work, 7 years and under, to be held by the school which the children attend. To be retained for one year, confined to the Metropolitan Borough of Kirklees.

The Sue Asher Trophy to be awarded for the best art work, any media, 7 years and under. To be retained for one year.
